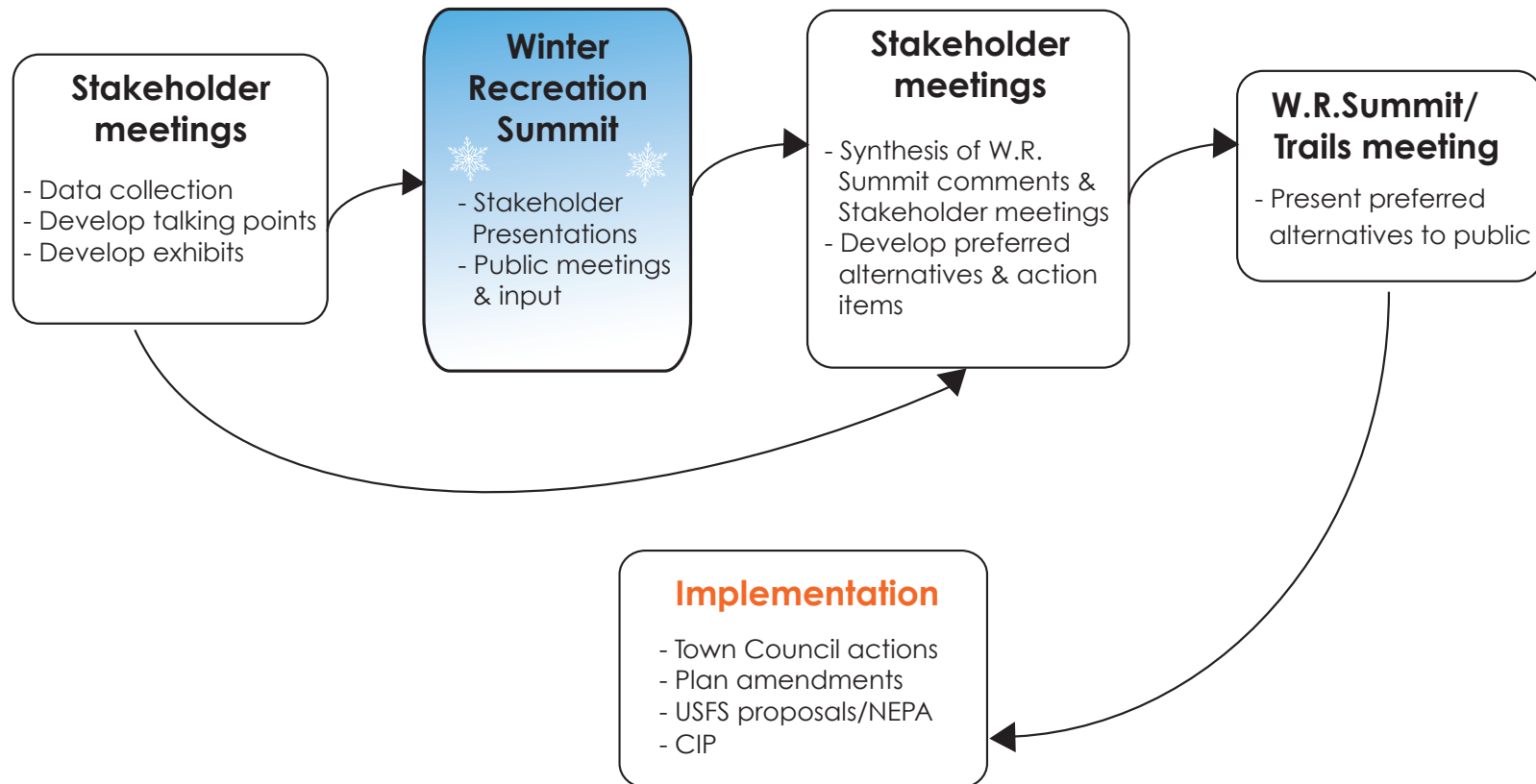

# Shady Rest Park Background

- Park Info
  - Location
  - 12.5 Acres
  - Under USFS Use Permit
  - Most Used Town Park
- Seasons
  - Summer May – November
  - Winter November - May



# Shady Rest Park Seasonal Uses

- Current Summer Uses
  - Picnic Areas, Playground, Restrooms, Skate Park, Soccer Fields, Softball Fields, Volleyball Courts,
  - Approximately 200 parking spaces
- Current Winter Uses
  - Groomed Nordic Trails
  - OSV Staging
  - Snow Play Identified in TSMP

Please enjoy this free Nordic Trail System responsibly:

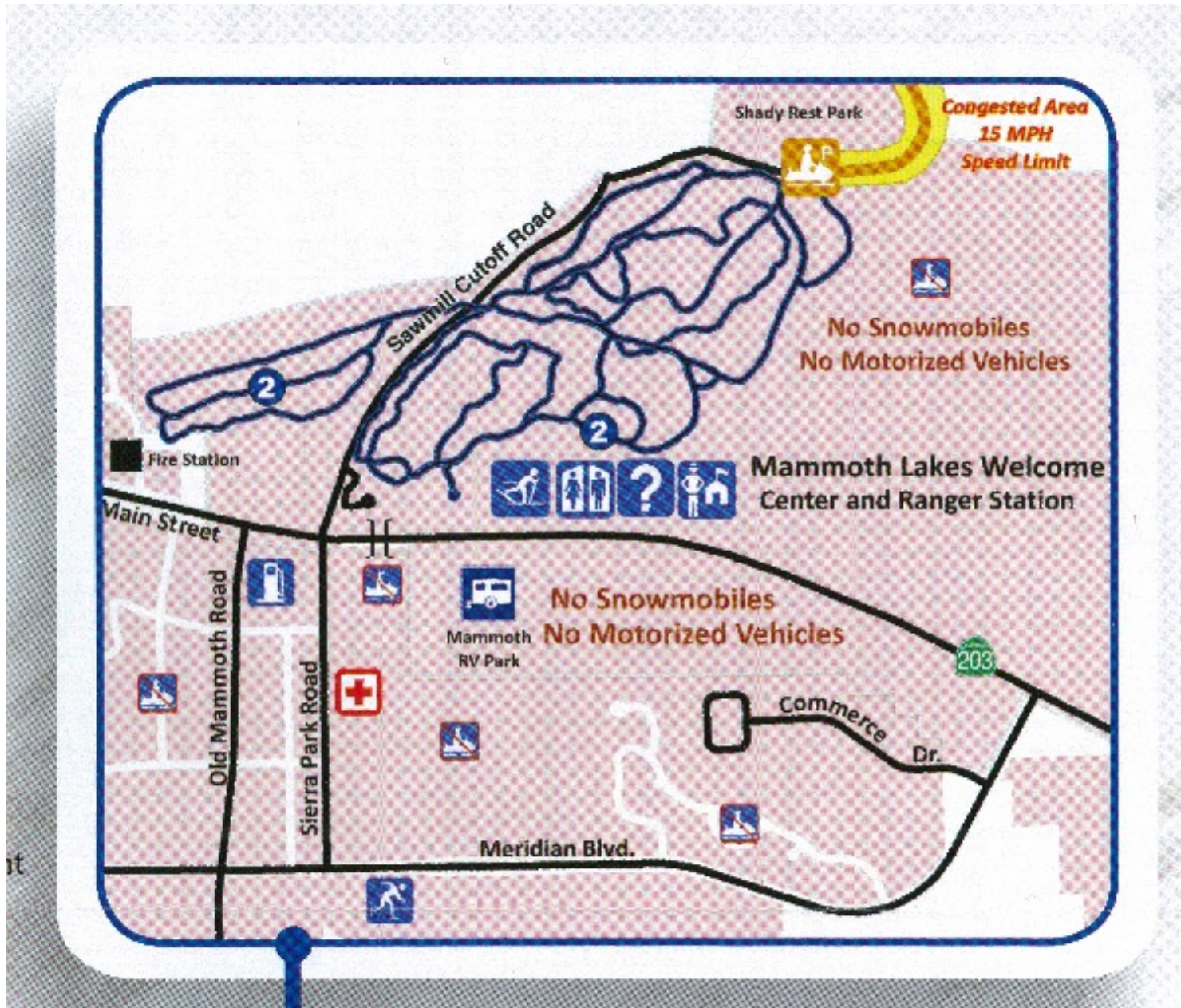
- Respect other users - maintain a safe speed and do not walk on parallel tracks
