Using the Ranch Road Winter Egress:

If you're planning to get back to town by way of the Snowcreek Golf Course and the public access easement at Ranch Road, you'll be crossing private property.

PLEASE FOLLOW THE FOUR RED SIGNS WHICH MARK THE LEGAL EXIT ROUTE TO RANCH ROAD.

Following this route and respecting the privacy of adjoining private-property owners will protect all of our right to continue to use this route in the future.

ENTERING AVALANCHE TERRAIN

The terrain and travel routes beyond this point are in backcountry avalanche terrain. This area contains potentially dangerous slopes and avalanche paths that are not patrolled or controlled. Proceed at your own risk and only with the proper training and equipment.

KNOW THE RISKS AND BE PREPARED!

- IS YOUR GROUP PROPERLY TRAINED AND EQUIPPED? Backcountry skiing is dangerous – take an avalanche course before entering avalanche terrain. Everyone in your group should have an avalanche beacon, shovel, probe and knowledge of how to use them.
- DO YOU HAVE A PLAN? Ensure everyone knows and agrees to the plan. Do your objectives match the forecast? Do you have a backup plan? Tell someone WHERE you are going and WHEN you are returning.
- KNOW THE FORECAST. Visit mammothtrails.org or scan the QR code for the latest Eastern Sierra Avalanche Center forecast.
- ENSURE YOUR BEACON IS TRANSMITTING. Pass this checkpoint one at a time 10' apart.
