

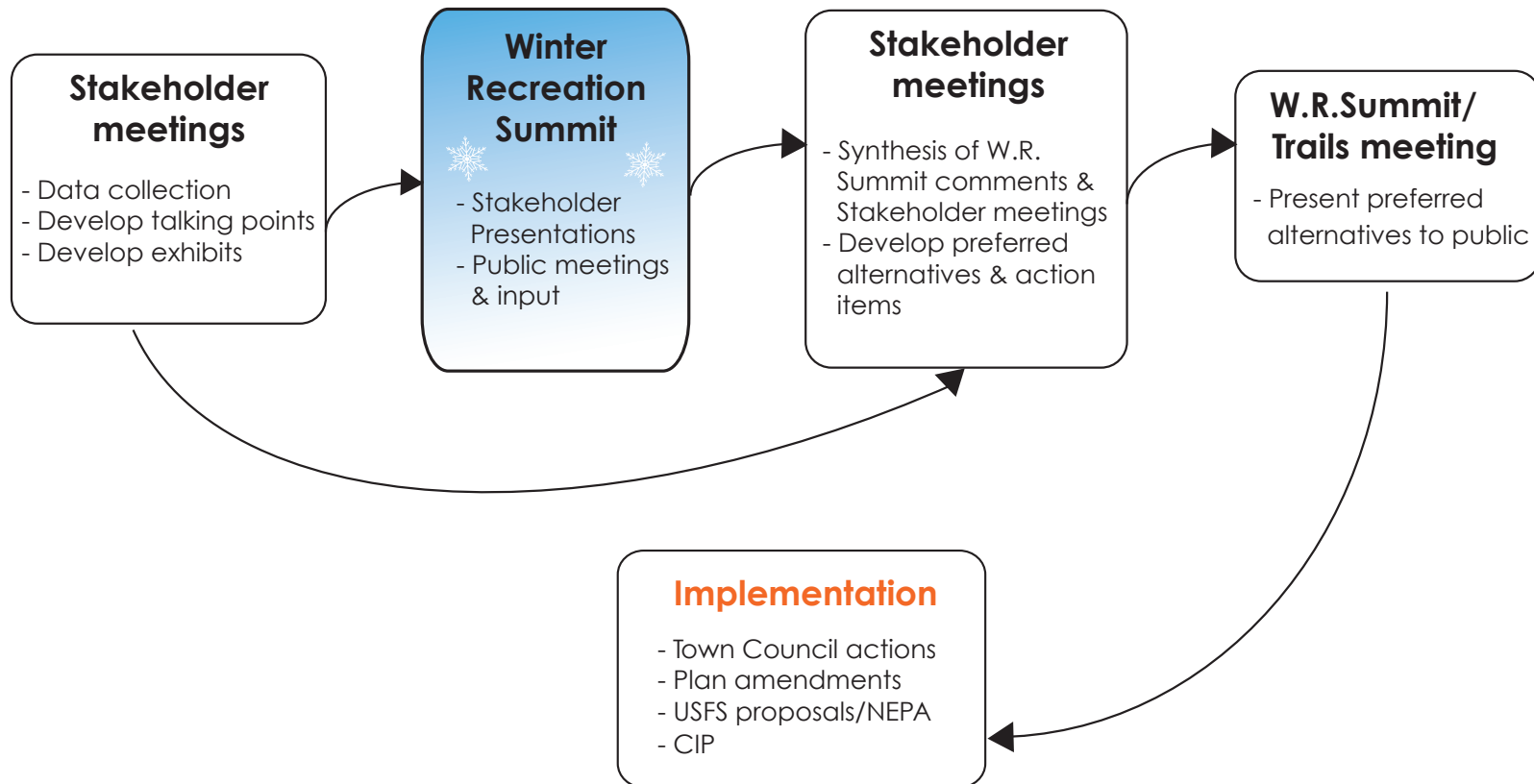

Town Snow Management – Current

- Goals
 - Public Safety is the Primary Concern
- Priorities
 - Support for Emergency Response
 - Main Arterials and Bus Routes
 - Secondary Residential Streets
 - Cul-de-sacs
 - Scenic Loop
 - Park and Ride
 - Sidewalks and Trails
 - Bus Shelters
 - Traffic Signals, Pedestrian Beacons



Town Equipment

- Six Loaders with Plow Blades
- Five Loader Mounter Snow Blowers
- Two Plow Trucks with Cinder Beds
- Two Trackless Sidewalk Snow Blowers
- One Skidsteer Snow Blower



Town Sidewalks and Paths

- Sidewalks
 - Old Mammoth Road
 - Tavern, Sierra Nevada and Sierra Park
 - Village Area
 - 2014: Meridian SRTS, Canyon (when conditions allow)
 - 2016/2017: Main Street, Mountain to Minaret
- Paths/MUPS
 - Meridian MUP near Schools
 - College Connector Path
 - Visitors Center
 - Lake Mary – Minaret to Kelly (when conditions allow)
 - Meadow Lane to Old Mammoth (when conditions allow)
