Over the last 8 years federal support has been flat to declining

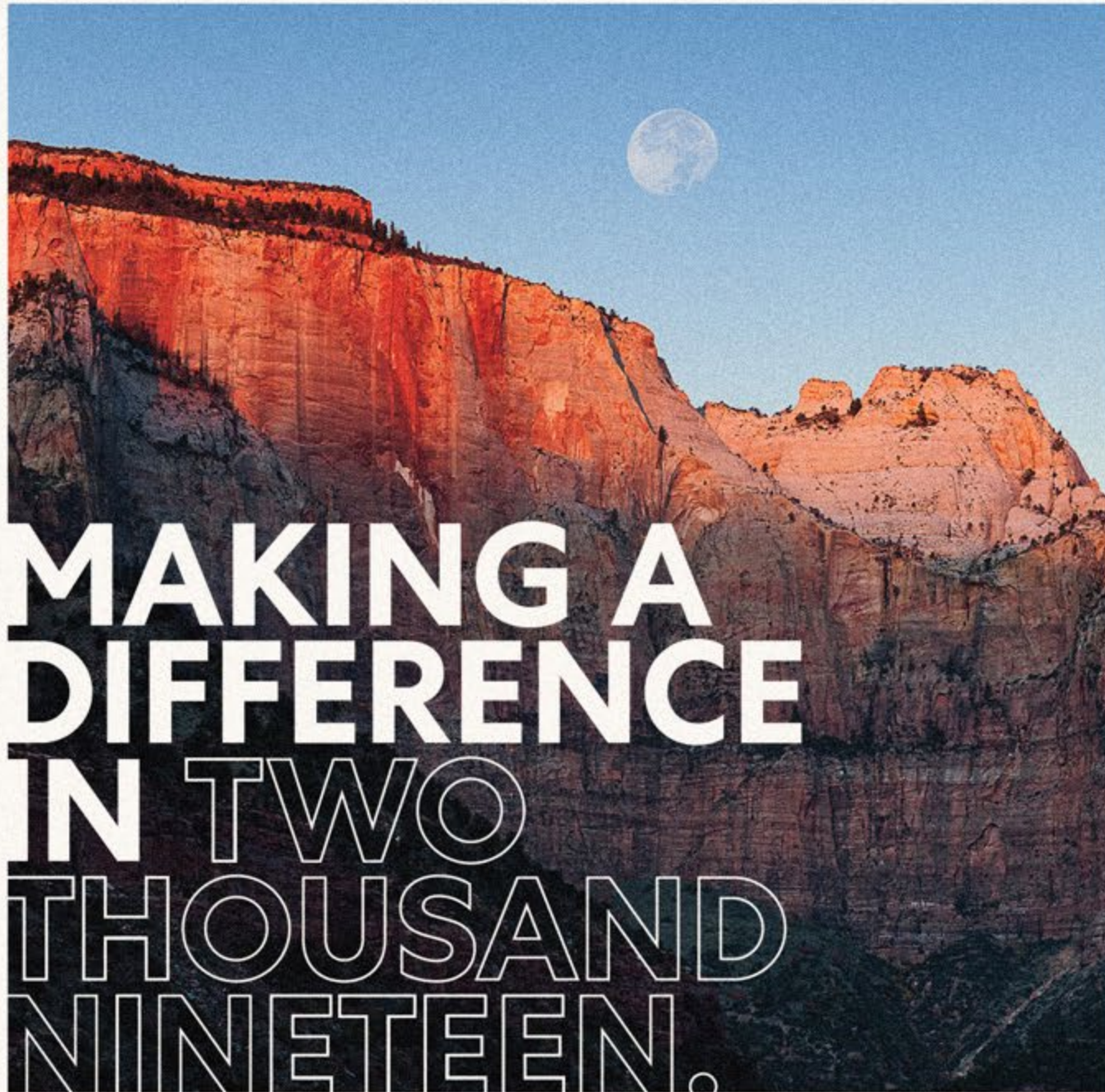
Zion is the third most visited National Park, surpassing Yellowstone and Yosemite
